TANGO CHINO + CARACOL

ESCENARIO HORACIO FERRER, CENTRO DE EXPOSICIONES (AV. FIGUEROA ALCORTA AND AV. PUEYRREDÓN). 7PM.

Prepare to be amazed (or, at the very least, stirred to the core) by this original, daring take on the tango tradition. Pianist Fulvio Giraudo and guitarist Edgardo "Chino" Rodríguez are Tango chino. The duo has the same lineup as the classic Salgán-De Lío team, but they take the definition of tango to a whole new level when they combine it with contemporary music and explore just how far they can take the genre before it breaks and dissolves (tango being such noble musical material, it playfully complies and goes the extra mile for them). La Plata classic singer Caracol, one of the most melodic and intense voices on the scene, seemed like an unlikely match for them—but they did come together, and it is a good thing.

The best example is their take on *Naranja en flor*, that legendary

melancholy gem on the gentler side of the River Plate tradition. In their version, it becomes gloriously schizophrenic: Caracol sings with all the passion and ten-

derness in the world, and in the background the duo unleashes a Schönberg-inspired fury of broken rhythm, twisted harmony and carefully orchestrated musical

chaos. The result? As W. B. Yeats once wrote, "a terrible beauty is born." And there's plenty more where that came from, so amazed you will be!
